NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF DRAFT REGULATIONS ENTITLED THE CHILD BENEFIT (CLAIMS AND PAYMENTS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1981

The Social Security Advisory Committee give notice that they have been asked by the Secretary of State for Social Services under Section 10 of the Social Security Act 1980 to consider and report on the draft of regulations entitled The Child Benefit (Claims and Payments) Amendment Regulations 1981.

These Regulations will apply to Great Britain only. Corresponding provision for Northern Ireland will be made in regulations made by the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland under the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 (SI 1975 No. 1504 N.I. 16). The Northern Ireland Regulations will not require prior submission to the Social Security Advisory Committee by virtue of paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to the Social Security Act 1980 (1980 C.30).

A short explanatory note provided by the Department of Health and Social Security on these regulations is appended to this notice. The Committee will take into account any comments or objections made by or on behalf of people or organizations who would be affected by the regulations received by them not later than 13th July 1981. EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations will amend the Child Benefit (Claims and Payments) Regulations and provide for child benefit to be paid 4-weekly from 15th March 1982. Existing beneficiaries will have a free choice of weekly or 4-weekly payment; a 6-month period of grace to revert to weekly payment if they cannot manage after they have tried 4-weekly payments; and the right at any time to move to weekly payments if they become lone parents, or receive supplementary benefit or family income supplement. Any new beneficiary who is in one of these exempted categories can also have weekly payment. Provision has also been made in the Regulations for payment to be made without hardship grounds to people outside the exempted groups both amongst new and existing beneficiaries.

MONOPOLY REFERENCE: THE SUPPLY OF PITCHES
FOR HOLIDAY CARAVANS IN NORTHERN IRELAND

The Director General of Fair Trading in exercise of his powers under sections 9(1), 47(1), 49(1) and 50(1) of the Fair Trading Act 1973 hereby refers to the Monopolies and Mergers Commission the matter of the existence or possible existence of a monopoly situation in relation to the service supplied by or on behalf of the licence-holder of making arrangements for a person to put or keep on land in Northern Ireland a caravan (within the meaning of Part I of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960) other than arrangements by virtue of which the person may occupy the caravan as his only or main residence and other than arrangements by which the person may put or keep a touring caravan on land.

The Monopolies and Mergers Commission shall upon this reference investigate and report in relation to such arrangements on the questions whether a monopoly situation exists by virtue of section 7(1) of the said Act, and, if so:

- in favour of what person or persons that monopoly situation exists;
- whether any steps (by way of uncompetitive practices or otherwise) are being taken by that person or those persons for the purpose of exploiting or maintaining the monopoly situation and, if so, by what uncompetitive practices or in what other way;
- whether any action or omission on the part of that person or those persons is attributable to the existence of the monopoly situation and, if so, what action or omission and in what way it was so attributable; and

- whether any facts found by the Commission in pursuance of these investigations operate, or may be expected to operate, against the public interest.

The "licence-holder" means a person who has applied for a site licence under s.3 of the Caravans Act (Northern Ireland) 1963 in accordance with the provisions in the Caravan Site (Licence Applications) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963 and to whom such Licence has been granted.

The Commission shall report upon this reference within a period of eighteen months from the date hereof.
