

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of Articles 17 and 25 of the Clean Air (N.I.) Order 1981, if on any day after the Smoke Control Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
3. Copies of the Smoke Control Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Environmental Health Department, City Hall, Belfast until 4th June, 1982.
4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Smoke Control Order may by notice

in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, Stormont, Belfast BT4 3SS object to its confirmation.
