DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22 of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of all other enabling powers made

on 31st March 1982 an Order entitled Traffic (Weight Restriction) (No. 4) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 104) which will come into operation on 18th May 1982.

The purpose of the order is to revoke the Traffic (Weight Restriction) (No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980 which prohibited vehicles exceeding 5 tons laden or unladen weight from using that part of Banagher Road (Route C523) in the townlands of Carnanbane and Templemoyle and County of Londonderry which is carried by Carnanbane Bridge over the Owenreagh River.

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 25 of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of all other enabling powers made on 9th April 1982 an Order entitled Restriction of Traffic (DR 64, Co. Antrim) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 112) which will come into operation on 10th May 1982.

The purpose of the order is to prohibit vehicles from using Route DR 64, Co. Antrim (known locally as Old Church Lane) from its junction with Route B105 (known locally as Soldierstown Road) to a point approximately 120 metres north-west of that junction for a period of 2 weeks from 10th May 1982.

The Department of the Environment has made a Statutory Rule entitled the Road Races (Tandragee 100) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 116).

This Order permits the North Armagh Motor Cycle and Car Club Limited as promoter of the Tandragee 100 motor cycle race to use for that race the following roads: That portion of Armagh Road (A51) from its junction with Drumnamether Road (B131) to its junction with Cooleyhill Road (C171).

That portion of Cooleyhill Road (C171) from its junction with Armagh Road (A51) to its junction with Markethill Road (B3).

That portion of Markethill Road (B3) from its junction with Cooleyhill Road (C171) to its junction with Drumnamether Road (B131).

That portion of Drumnamether Road (B131) from its junction with Markethill Road (B3) to its junction with Armagh Road (A51).

The right of way of other traffic will be suspended on 1st May 1982 from 12.00 noon to 6.30 p.m.

In effect this Order temporarily closes these roads.

The Department of the Environment has made a statutory Rule entitled the Road Races (Benbradagh Hill Climb) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 117).

This Order permits the Maiden City Motor Club Limited, as promoter of the Benbradagh Hill Climb, to use for that hill climb the following roads:

Curragh Road (DR252) from a point 10 metres north eastwards from its junction with Hass Road (DR252) to a point approximately 2000 metres east of its junction with Curragh Road (DR253).

Curragh Road (DR253) for a distance of 600 metres north-westwards from its junction with Curragh Road (DR252).

The right of way of other traffic will be suspended from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on 1st May 1982.

In effect this Order temporarily closes this road.
