EMPLOYMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment (Miscellaneous Provisions) (1981 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 249 (c.6)).

With effect from 3rd September 1982 and 3rd January 1983, this order brings into operation all the provisions of the Employment (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 which were not previously brought into force and which concern the licensing and control of employment agencies and employment businesses.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment Agencies and Businesses (Exemption) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 250).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations exempt certain bodies from the provisions of Part II of the Employment (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 concerning the licensing and control of employment agencies and employment businesses.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment Agencies and Businesses (Licence Applications) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 251).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations prescribe the manner in which application for a licence for an employment agency and/or employment business must be made and the particulars which must accompany such an application.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment Agencies and Businesses (Licence Fee) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 252).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations prescribe the fees payable on the grant or renewal of a licence for an employment agency and/or employment business, including the grant of a new licence to a currently licensed employment agency or employment business which is transferred to other premises.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Conduct of Employment Agencies and Businesses Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 253).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations impose duties on persons carrying on employment agencies and employment businesses in order to secure that such agencies and businesses are properly conducted, and to protect the interests of persons using their services.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment Agencies (Charging Fees to Workers) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 254).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations provide that, with certain exceptions, an employment agency may charge a fee to a person seeking employment in certain occupations within the entertainment industry or as a fashion or photographic model.

Notice is hereby given that on 5th August 1982 following consultation, the Department of Manpower Services made a statutory rule entitled the Employment Agencies (Charging Fees to Au Pairs) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1982 (SR 1982 No. 255).

With effect from 3rd September 1982, these regulations provide that, in certain circumstances, an employment agency may charge a fee, not exceeding £40, for finding a person employment as an au pair outside the United Kingdom.
