These regulations supersede the Offals in Meat Products Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1960, the Meat Pie and Sausage Roll Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967, the Canned Meat Product Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967, the Sausage and Other Meat Product Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967 and the Fish and Meat Spreadable Products Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968.

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 13 and 68 of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958 the Department of Health and Social Services has made regulations entitled: Meat (Sterilisation and Staining) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984 (SR 1984 No. 416).

These regulations, which revoke the Meat (Sterilisation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969, require, subject to exemptions, that:

- (a) meat unfit for human consumption removed from a slaughterhouse;
  - (b) meat removed from a knackery;
  - (c) meat unfit, or not intended, for human consumption removed from a port or other place of entry; and
  - (d) meat of a specified kind unfit for human consumption removed from any other place
- shall be sterilised or stained before its removal.
