FISHERIES ACTS (NORTHERN IRE-LAND), 1842-1928.

BY-LAW.

POLLEN FISHING, LOUGH ERNE.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Fisheries Acts (Northern Ireland), 1842-1928, and of every other power it thereunto enabling, being of opinion that the authorisation of the use for the capture of pollen in Lough Erne of nets with meshes of a less size than that specified in Section 11 of the Fisheries (Ireland) Act, 1845, is desirable, makes and ordains the following By-Law:—

It is hereby permitted to use for the capture of pollen in Upper and Lower Loughs Erne, between the first day of February and the 31st day of October in any year, both days inclusive, trammel or set nets, composed of thread or yarn of a fine texture, being not more that 110 lea two-ply linen or 100 lea six-ply cotton, with a mesh being in no place less than one inch from knot to knot, or greater than one and one-quarter inches from knot to knot.

In witness whereof the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland has hereunto set its Official Seal this ninth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.
