SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

A vacancy exists for a Second Class Clerk in the Principal Probate Registry under the Supreme Court of Judicature of Northern Ireland. Salary for men, £120—£15—£300 a year, with bonus in addition (at present £120 carries £68). Salary for women, £100-£10-£250 a year, with bonus (at present £100 carries £62).
