NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE (INSURANCE PRACTITIONERS' AND PHARMACEUTICAL COMMITTEES)

REGULATIONS

(NORTHERN IRELAND), 1930.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland hereby give notice that Regulations have been made under the National Health Insurance Acts, 1924 to 1930, prescribing the constitution of Committees of medical practitioners and pharmaceutical chemists, to be known as Local Insurance Practitioners' Committees, Central Insurance Practitioners' Committees and Local Pharmaceutical Committees, and the procedure to be adopted by those Committees.

MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 2, Sub-section (4) of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, the Board of Trade give notice that in pursuance of an application received by them for the making of an Order in Council to require imported adhesive insulating tape for electrical purposes to bear an indication of origin, they have made a reference to the Standing Committee appointed by them under the Act in respect thereof.

Attention is called to the fact that, while, under the provisions of the above Act, the Committee must in every case referred to them consider whether the goods should bear an indication of origin at the time of sale or exposure for sale, they may also at their discretion consider and report upon the question whether such goods should bear an indication of origin at the time of importation.

SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

A vacancy exists for a Second Class Clerk in the Principal Probate Registry under the Supreme Court of Judicature of Northern Ireland. Salary for men, £120—£15—£300 a year, with bonus in addition (at present £120 carries £68). Salary for women, £100—£10—£250 a year, with bonus (at present £100 carries £62).

Candidates must have attained the age of 20, and must not have attained the age of 22 on 21st February next, but the upper age limit may be extended to 30 in the case of candidates with professional legal qualifications or experi-

ence of legal business, and to 50 in the case of certain categories of employees under the Supreme Court.

The regulations governing the competition to be held to fill this post, together with the forms on which applications must be made, may be obtained on request from the Secretary, Supreme Court of Judicature of Northern Ireland, Law Courts, Belfast. The latest date for the receipt of applications on the prescribed form is Saturday, 21st February, 1931.

THE SAFEGUARDING OF INDUSTRIES (EXEMPTION) No. 1 ORDER, 1931, dated 29-1-1931, made by the Treasury under Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926 (16 & 17 Geo. 5, c. 22).

WHEREAS it is provided by Sub-section (5) of Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926 (16 & 17 Geo. 5, c. 22) that the Treasury may by order exempt from the duty imposed by Section one of the Safeguarding of Industries Act, 1921 (11 & 12 Geo. 5, c. 47), as amended by the Finance Act, 1926, for such period as may be specified in the Order, any article in respect of which the Board of Trade are satisfied on a representation made by a consumer of that article that the article is not made in any part of His Majesty's Dominions in quantities which are substantial, having regard to the consumption of that article for the time being in the United Kingdom, and that there is no reasonable probability that the article will within a reasonable period be made in His Majesty's Dominions in such substantial quantities:

AND Whereas the Board of Trade are satisfied on representations made by consumers of the articles specified in the Schedule to this Order that those articles are not made in any part of His Majesty's Dominions in quantities which are substantial, having regard to the consumption of those articles for the time being in the United Kingdom, and that there is no reasonable probability that those articles will within a reasonable period be made in His Majesty's Dominions in such substantial quantities:

Now, Therefore, We, being two of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in pursuance of the powers conferred on us by the said Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1926, and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf, hereby order as follows:—

1. Such of the articles mentioned in the Schedule of this Order as are not entered under the Customs Acts before the day of February 3rd, 1931, or which have not been removed from a bonded warehouse before that date, shall be exempt from the duty imposed by Section one of the Safeguarding of Industries Act, 1921, as amended by the Finance Act, 1926, for a period ending on the 31st day of December, 1931.

2. This Order may be cited as the Safeguarding of Industries (Exemption) No. 1 Order, 1931.

NOTES.—(a) Each holding when vested in the purchaser shall continue to have appurtenant thereto, and to be subject to, as the case may be, any previously existing easements, rights and appurtenances.
