INDIRECT ELECTROSTATIC PHOTOCOPIERS AND DIGITAL COPIERS

Whereas by a reference dated 12th September, 1990, the Director General of Fair Trading in exercise of his powers under sections 47(1), 49(1) and 50(1) of the Fair Trading Act 1973 referred to the Monopolies and Mergers Commission the matter of the existence or the possible existence of a monopoly situation in relation to the supply in the United Kingdom by manufacturers and importers of indirect electrostatic photocopiers:

Now therefore the Director General of Fair Trading in exercise of his powers under section 52(1) of the said Act hereby varies the said reference by adding at the end of the first paragraph (that is, immediately following the word "photocopiers") the words "and indirect electrostatic digital copiers".

The Scheme amends the Farm and Conservation Grant Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1989 ("The Principal Scheme") and complies with Article 8 of Council Regulations (EEC) No. 797/85 (OJ No. L93, 30.5.85, p.1) on improving the efficiency of agricultural structures, as amended by Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1760/87 (OJ No. L167, 26.6.87, p.1) and Council Regulation (EEC) No. 3808/89 (OJ No. L371, 20.12.89, p.1).

The Scheme amends the principal Scheme to provide that the Department of Agriculture shall not pay grant thereunder in relation to any expenditure if at the time the expenditure was incurred the agricultural business in relation to which the expenditure was incurred was the subject of an improvement plan drawn up or a farm investment schedule approved under or by virtue of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4253/88 (OJ No. L374, 31.12.88, p.1) laying down provisions for implementing Regulation (EEC) No. 2052/88 (OJ No. L185, 15.7.88, p.9) as regards co-ordination of the activities of the different Structural Funds between themselves and with the operations of the European Investment Bank and the other existing financial instruments, and Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4256/88 (OJ No. L374, 31.12.88, p.25) laying down provisions for implementing Regulation (EEC) No. 2052/88 as regards the EAGGF, Guidance Section.
