POST OFFICE SCHEME C1/1991

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this note amends the Post Office (Postal Order) Scheme 1971. The amending Scheme, which comes into operation on 26 September 1991, provides for the withdrawal of postal orders for sums of less than $\pounds 1$, with the exception of postal orders for 50 pence.

It revokes the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 16) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 1/1985).

THE POST OFFICE (POSTAL ORDER) AMENDMENT (No. 17) SCHEME 1991

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and citation

1. This Scheme:

(a) shall come into operation on 26 September 1991;

(b) may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 17) Scheme 1991;

(c) shall be read as one with the Post Office, (Postal Order) Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P5/1971) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P4/1973) and the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 15) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 5/1984).

Issue of amounts of postal orders

2. For sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 4 of the Scheme there shall be substituted the following:

- "(1) Postal Orders may be issued for the following sums:
 - (a) the sum of 50 pence and one pound;
 - (b) any sum greater than one pound as the Post Office may from time to time determine".

Revocation

3. The Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 16) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 1/1985) made on 15 August 1985 is hereby revoked.

INDEX-LINKED NATIONAL SAVINGS

MOVEMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM GENERAL INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES

For the purposes of revaluing on repayment Index-linked National Savings Certificates (Retirement Issue, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Indexlinked issues) and contributions under Save As You Earn savings contracts (Third Issue) and for revising the annual rate of interest for Indexed-Income Bonds, the Index figure issued by the Central Statistical Office in the month of September and applicable to the month of October is 134.1. This figure is based on the revised reference base of 100 adopted in January 1987. In accordance with the relevant prospectuses a notional Index figure of 529.0 has been calculated and will apply to Index-linked Savings Certificates and Indexed-Income Bonds purchased in March 1987 or earlier and SAYE contributions which were due for payment and made in February 1987 or earlier.
