The Department being of the opinion that parts of the above-mentioned roads are no longer necessary for road traffic hereby gives notice of its intention to make an Order under Article 40 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 the effect of which would be to abandon the entire length of Havelock Place together with a length of approximately 14 metres of Havelock Street, in the City of Belfast.
