

KIRKLAND SQUARE, CARRICKFERGUS (FOOTWAY)

The Department being of the opinion that parts of the above-mentioned footway are no longer necessary for road traffic hereby gives notice of its intention to make an Order under Article 40 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 the effect of which would be to abandon the following lengths of footway in Kirkland Square in the town of Carrickfergus and County of Antrim:

a strip of footway approximately 52 metres long by 0.75 metres wide fronting Nos. 1 to 11 (part); and

a strip of footway approximately 80 metres long by 0.75 metres wide fronting Nos. 35 to 55 (part).

The lengths of footway proposed to be abandoned are delineated on a map which, together with a copy of the draft Order, may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period from 10th April, 1992 to 18th May, 1992 at the Department's Roads Service Headquarters, Room 214, Commonwealth House, 35 Castle Street, Belfast BT1 1GU; at the Department's Divisional Roads Service, Ballymena Division, County Hall, Galgorm Road, Ballymena; and at the Department's Divisional Roads Service Section Office, 10 Governor's Place, Carrickfergus.

Any person may within the said period object to the proposal by written notice to Roads Service Headquarters at the address above stating the grounds of objection.

GAME PRESERVATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1928**GAME LAW AMENDMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1951**

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment proposes to make an Order under the above-mentioned Acts:

1. prohibiting the sale or purchase of grouse for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere by human beings or animals at any time from 11th August, 1992 to 11th August 1993;
2. prohibiting the killing or taking of partridge, red-legged partridges or hen pheasants at any time from 30th September 1992 to 30th September 1993 except where exemption is granted by the Department;
3. Prohibiting the sale or purchase of partridge, red-legged partridges or hen pheasants for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere by human beings or animals at any time from 30th September, 1992 to 30th September 1993 except partridge, red-legged partridges or hen pheasants killed by a person exempted under paragraph 2, which may be sold to a licensed game dealer.

Any person objecting to any of these proposals should do so in writing to the Countryside and Wildlife Branch of the Department, Calvert House, 23 Castle Place, Belfast BT1 1FY, not later than 29th May, 1992.
