PUBLIC HEALTH (PRESERVATIVES, ETC., IN FOOD) (NORTHERN IRELAND) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1931.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878, the Public Health Act, 1896, the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1896, the Public Health (Regulations as to Food) Act, 1907, and the Butter and Margarine Act, 1907, and of every other power enabling the Ministry in that behalf, has made further Regulations regarding the use of Preservatives, etc., in Food in Northern Ireland.

The object of these Regulations is to postpone until the 1st January, 1933, the operation of the Public Health (Preservatives, etc., in Food) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1927, in so far as they prohibit the use of preservative in cream or in any article of food in which preservative is necessarily introduced by the use in its preparation of preserved cream.

TRADE BOARDS ACT (NORTHERN (IRELAND), 1923.

LINEN AND COTTON HANDKERCHIEF AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND LINEN PIECE GOODS TRADE BOARD (NORTHERN IRELAND).

The Trade Board established by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland under powers conferred by the Trade Boards Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, for the Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Trade in Northern Ireland, as defined in the Schedule to the Trade Boards (Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Trade, Northern Ireland) (Constitution, Proceedings, and Meetings) Regulations, 1924, dated the 17th November, 1924, hereby give notice that they propose to fix certain additional general minimum piece-rates and to vary certain other general minimum piece-rates and general overtime rates for female workers.

On request to the Trade Board, particulars of the proposed minimum rates and variation of minimum rates and information as to their application will be given if, in the opinion of the Trade Board, the applicant is likely to be affected thereby.

The Trade Board will consider any objections to their proposals which may be lodged with them within one calendar month from the 1st day of September, 1931, in respect of their proposal to fix minimum rates and within fourteen days from the 1st day of September, 1931, in respect of their proposal to vary minimum rates. Such objections should be in writing, and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address) and should be sent to the Secretary of the Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Trade Board (Northern Ireland), Office of Trade Boards, Stormont, Belfast. It is desirable that persons making objections should state, as far as possible, the precise grounds therefor.
