Remuneration of Consultants — Distinction and Meritorious Service Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992

These regulations which have an operative date of 1 September 1992, replace with amendments the Health and Personal Social Services (Remuneration of Consultants and Specialists — Distinction Awards) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974.

The regulations empower the Department of Health and Social Services to determine the number, amounts and allocation of Distinction and Meritorious Service Awards to medical or dental officers in the consultant grades, having regard to the recommendations of the advisory committee known as "the Distinction and Meritorious Service Awards Committee for Northern Ireland".
