### NORTHERN IRELAND COURT SERVICE

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Articles 23(1), 74(4)(a) and 141(1) and (2) of Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 has made a Statutory Rule entitled the Judgment Enforcement (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1993.

These rules, which come into operation on 1st October, 1993, amend the Judgment Enforcement Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981 to -

- (a) delete Part 2 and Schedule 2 to take account of the discontinuance of the Payments for Debt (Emergency Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1971;
- (b) amend Rule 106 and substitute a new Schedule to increase the costs payable in enforcement proceedings and to provide for the costs of certain proceedings to be in the discretion of the Master; and
- (c) substitute in Schedule 1 a new Form 3 to take account of the recoupment of sums equivalent to Social Security benefits provisions contained in the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992.

These rules also amend the Judgments Enforcement (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 to -

- (a) increase from £1,000 to £3,000 the amount that the outstanding balance of all monies due and payable under a judgment must exceed before a creditor may apply for a custody warrant and report under Article 23(1); and
- (b) increase, from 50p to £1, the amount which under Article 74(4)(a) an employer may deduct from a debtor's earnings towards the clerical and administrative costs of the employer complying with an Attachment of Earnings Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 13 of the Magistrates' Courts (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, on the advice of the Magistrates' Courts Rules Committee and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, has made a statutory rule entitled Magistrates' Courts (Domestic Proceedings) (Amendment No. 2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1993.

These rules, which come into operation on 24th August, 1993, amend the Magistrates' Courts (Domestic Proceedings) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1980 to substitute a new Rule 13 to take account of the coming into operation of the amendment made to Article 21(2) of the Domestic Proceedings (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 [S.I. 1980/563 (N.I.5)] by Article 14(2) of the Family Law (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 [S.I. 1993/1576 (N.I.6)].

The new Rule 13 provides that where an applicant makes a statement to a clerk of petty sessions that the applicant or a child of the family is in imminent danger of physical injury, the clerk of petty sessions shall take steps to ensure that the court or resident magistrate considers as soon as is practicable whether or not to make an interim personal protection order or interim exclusion order.

This Order amends the list of designated countries, makes consequential amendments,

and provides for definition and certification of the institution of proceedings in a designated country.

This Order adds to the list of designated countries, makes consequential amendments, and provides for definition and certification of the institution of proceedings in a designated country.

PUBLIC LOCAL INQUIRY AND PUBLIC INSPECTION OF OBJECTIONS

*Public Inquiry*

The Department of The Environment for Northern Ireland has decided to cause a Public Local Inquiry to be held under Article 7 of The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, for the purpose of considering objections to the above Plan.

The Area Plan was prepared under Part III of The Planning (NI) Order 1991 and was published in March 1993. Anyone who wished to object to any of the policies or proposals contained in the Plan was invited to do so in writing before June 4th, 1993.

The Planning Appeals Commission will conduct the Public Inquiry and report thereon to the Department. The Inquiry will be held in the Council Chamber, The Town Hall, The Square, Ballyclare, Commencing at 11.00 am on Tuesday 2nd November, 1993 and continuing on such other days and at such times as may be determined by the Commissioner appointed by the Planning Appeals Commission to preside at the Inquiry.

For the purpose of the Inquiry, the Plan comprises the written statement and maps published in March 1993, entitled Newtownabbey Area Plan 2005. *As a result of the consideration of objections and the Commission's Report on the Public Inquiry the Area Plan may be subject to changes which will finally be confirmed in the Department's Adoption Statement.*

*Public Inspection of Objections*

The Planning (Development Plans) Regulations (NI) 1991 requires the Department to make copies of all objections to a Development Plan, which are to be considered at a forthcoming Public Inquiry, available for public inspection prior to the Inquiry.
