Public Local Inquiry and Public Inspection of Objections

Public Inquiry

The Department of The Environment for Northern Ireland has decided to cause a Public Local Inquiry to be held under Article 7 of The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, for the purpose of considering objections to the above Plan.

The Area Plan was prepared under Part III of The Planning (NI) Order 1991 and was published in March 1993. Anyone who wished to object to any of the policies or proposals contained in the Plan was invited to do so in writing before June 4th, 1993.

The Planning Appeals Commission will conduct the Public Inquiry and report thereon to the Department. The Inquiry will be held in the Council Chamber, The Town Hall, The Square, Ballyclare, Commencing at 11.00 am on Tuesday 2nd November, 1993 and continuing on such other days and at such times as may be determined by the Commissioner appointed by the Planning Appeals Commission to preside at the Inquiry.

For the purpose of the Inquiry, the Plan comprises the written statement and maps published in March 1993, entitled Newtownabbey Area Plan 2005. As a result of the consideration of objections and the Commission's Report on the Public Inquiry the Area Plan may be subject to changes which will finally be confirmed in the Department's Adoption Statement.

Public Inspection of Objections

The Planning (Development Plans) Regulations (NI) 1991 requires the Department to make copies of all objections to a Development Plan, which are to be considered at a forthcoming Public Inquiry, available for public inspection prior to the Inquiry.
