ONE-WAY TRAFFIC, BOYLAN ROAD, GLENLOUGH, BALLYMONEY

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT, SYDENHAM BY-PASS, ROUTE A2, BELFAST

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 51(5) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of all other enabling powers made on 17th July, 1995 an Order entitled Temporary Speed Limit (Sydenham By-Pass, Route A2, Belfast) (Continuation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 (SR 1995 No. 288) which will come into operation on 1st September 1995.

The purpose of the Order is to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour on both carriageways of Sydenham By-Pass, Route A2, Belfast, from a point approximately 300 metres east of its junction with Dee Street, to a point approximately 300 metres east of its junction with Connsbank Road, and at more than 40 miles per hour on the eastbound carriageway of Sydenham By-Pass, Route A2, Belfast, from a point approximately 230 metres west of its junction with Dee Street, to a point approximately 300 metres east of that junction for a period of 11 months commencing on 1st September, 1995 in the interests of safety while roadworks are in progress.
