

- (d) the construction of a new sluice gate on the Gallagher millrace
- (e) remedial works to the existing flood wall at Fenaghy Road
- (f) remedial works to Lisnafillin weir
- (g) scour protection to Gracehill and Bridge End Bridges.

Having determined that the proposed works are not, by reason amongst other things of their nature, size or location, likely to have significant environmental effects it is the Department's intention not to prepare an Environmental Statement.

CONTROL OF TRAFFIC, BELFAST

- (a) In a south-westerly direction along Royal Avenue, Belfast, on reaching its junction with North Street, to make a right-hand turn into North Street; and
- (b) In a northerly direction along Queen Street, Belfast, on reaching its junction with College Street,
 - (i) to make a right-hand turn into that part of College Street between its junction with Fountain Street and its junction with Queen Street; or
 - (ii) to make a left-hand turn into that part of College Street between its junction with Queen Street and its junction with College Square East.
