1. The birds must be accompanied by a Health Certificate signed by a Local Veterinary Inspector appointed by the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food stating that:
 - (a) the birds were inspected within 48 hours prior to export and were found to be healthy and free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and fit to travel;
 - (b) a written declaration has been received from the owner stating that the said birds have been kept on the premises of origin for at least 35 days immediately preceding export;
 - (c) no case of avian influenza has been diagnosed on the premises of origin during the 30 days preceding dispatch;
 - (d) the birds do not come from premises or an area subject to any restrictions under Council Directive 92/66/EEC introducing Community measures for the control of Newcastle Disease;
for Psittacines only: (which includes Parrots, Macaws, Cockatoos, Cockatiels and Budgerigars);
 - (e) they do not come from premises nor have been in contact with animals from premises on which psittacosis (*Chlamydia psittaci*) has been diagnosed within a period of at least 2 months prior to the date of exportation;
 - (f) they are identified by a leg-band bearing an individual number which is unique to that bird.
2. The importer must inform the Divisional Veterinary Officer for the premises of destination within 24 hours of importation or, if importation is on a Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday, on the first working day thereafter.

NOTE:

Exotic birds include all species not subject to Council Directive 90/539/EEC ie all birds other than fowl, turkeys, guinea fowl, ducks, geese, quails, pigeons, pheasants, partridges and ratites reared or kept in captivity for breeding, the production of meat or eggs for consumption, or for re-stocking supplies of game.

Quarries Miscellaneous Health and Safety Provisions Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995

- (b) provisions of the Extractive Industries (Boreholes) Directive (No. 92/91/EEC) dealing with matters such as the organisation of the workplace, mechanical and electrical equipment, plant, maintenance, ventilation, temperature, rooms, lighting, doors, gates, traffic routes, danger areas, outdoor workplaces, pregnant women, working mothers and sanitary installations.

The Regulations come into operation on 31st December, 1995, except regulation 11 which comes into operation on 5th October, 1998.

Part III provides the protection of certain wild animals and plants and makes it an offence to, subject to certain exceptions, deliberately to capture kill or disturb those animals or trade in them or to pick, collect, cut, uproot or destroy those plants or trade in them;

Part IV makes provision for the adaptation of planning and certain other consents for the protection of European sites and makes special provision as respects general development orders, special development orders, simplified planning zones and enterprise zones. Specifically it is a requirement to:

- (i) consider the effect on a European site of a grant of planning permission and, subject to certain exceptions, restrict the grant of planning permission where the integrity of a European site would be adversely affected;
- (ii) review and in certain circumstances revoke planning permissions granted before the date on which a site becomes a European site where the integrity of the site would be adversely affected;
- (iii) take similar action to assess the effect on a European site in relation to the construction of roads under the Roads (NI) Order 1993, waste disposal licences under the Pollution control and Local Government (NI) Order 1978, and discharge consents under the Water (NI) Act 1972;
