* NOTE.—The Residuary Share of Reserved Taxes is the net receipt of Residuary Revenue after deduction of the following :—(a) the estimated cost of Reserved Services ; (b) the Northern Ireland Contribution towards Imperial Expenditure ; (c) New Land Purchase Annuities and (d) Local Loans Repayments (Imperial). It is paid over by the Imperial Treasury in instalments based on an estimate for the financial year and an adjustment is made when the true Residuary Share has been finally ascertained.
