PLANNING (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1998 No. 223

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 127 and 129(1) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, made on 18th June 1998 a Statutory Rule entitled the Planning (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998 No. 223 which will come into operation on 1st August 1998.

These regulations amend the Planning (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995.

The Regulations:

- (1) increase the fees for planning appeals from £100 to £120 (regulation 2 (2)); and
- (2) insert a new fee currently £30 for determinations on the need for prior approval for development by Telecommunications Code System Operators permitted under Part 17 of Schedule 1 to the Planning (General Development) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 (regulation 2 (3)).

Notice of Intention to make an Abandonment Order

The Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland being of the opinion that part of the above-mentioned footway is not necessary for road traffic proposes to make an order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 the effect of which would be to abandon an area of approximately 9 square metres of footway to the front of Nos. 5 to 7 (part) Church Street in the town of Tandragee and County of Armagh.
