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## Proclamation by The Secretary of State

12th JULY 1999 - BANK HOLIDAY

The Rt. Hon. Dr. Marjorie Mowlam MP, Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers conferred on her by the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, has signed an Order appointing Monday, 12th July, 1999, a Bank and Public Holiday in Northern Ireland.

## **Ulster Savings Certificates** Common Extension Terms

The Department of Finance and Personnel has issued a Direction decreasing from 3.24% to 3.00% per annum the rate of interest on Ulster Savings Certificates to which common extension terms apply. The new rate will operate and accrue from 1st February, 1999 and until

The common extension terms apply to Certificates of the National Defence, Supplementary, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Fourteenth, Sixteenth, Eighteenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-first, Twenty-third, Twenty-fourth, Twenty-fifth, Twenty-sixth, Twentyseventh, Twenty-eighth, Twenty-ninth, Thirtieth, Thirty-first, Thirty-second, Thirty-third, Thirty-fourth, Thirty-fifth, Thirty-sixth, Thirtyseventh, Thirty-eighth, Thirty-ninth, Fortieth and Forty-first Issues. The common extension terms were introduced by regulations made on 15th June, 1982 (S.R. 1982 No. 178).





# Roads (NI) Order ROADS Service

# THE BELFAST – BALLYGAWLEY – LONDONDERRY TRUNK ROAD T3

The Department of the Environment hereby gives notice in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 8 to the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 that it proposes to make an order under Article 14 of that Order. The proposed order will –

1. provide that approximately 440 metres of existing road in the townlands of Drumenny Little, Drumenny Big and Magherareagh, County of Tyrone from a point approximately 39 metres south of its junction with Drumenny Road and Lisdivin Road and extending in a northerly direction to a point approximately 118 metres north of its junction with Ash Avenue more particularly delineated and coloured orange on the map and 470 metres of proposed new road in the townlands of Loughneas and Magherareagh, County of Tyrone from a point on the existing trunk road T3 approximately 225 metres south of the junction of A5 Victoria Road with Drumenny Road and Lisdivin Road and extending in a northerly direction to a point approximately 245 metres north of the junction of A5 Victoria Road with Drumenny Road and Lisdivin Road shall become trunk road and be part of the Trunk Road T3; 2. provide for the revocation of the Trunk Road T3 (Burndennet) Order (Northern Ireland) 1996 ("the 1996 Order") as the new route therein described was never constructed. It also makes provision for the trunking of the length of road detrunked by the 1996 Order.

The Department also proposes to improve the junction which exists between Drumenny Road/Lisdivin Road and A5 Victoria Road.

The proposals are delineated on a map which, together with a copy of the draft order, may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period from 29th January. 1999 to 8th March, 1999, at the Department's Roads Service offices, Headquarters, Room 231, Clarence Court. 10-18 Adelaide Street. Belfast, Omagh Division, County Hall, Drumragh Avenue, Omagh and "Elmview", Derry Road, Strabane; and at the offices of Strabane District Council, 47 Derry Road, Strabane.

Any person may, within the said period, object to the making of the order by written notice to the Department at County Hall, Drumragh Avenue, Omagh, BT79 7AP, stating the grounds of objection.

# LARKFIELD AVENUE/UPPER LISBURN ROAD, BELFAST NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE AN ABANDONMENT ORDER

The Department of the Environment has made a Statutory Rule entitled Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999 (S.R. 1999 No. 9).

These Regulations which come into operation on 22nd February, 1999, will require:

- (i) all goods vehicles over 12 tonnes, first registered on or after 1st January 1988, to display a speed limiter plate showing the set speed as 85 km/h; and
- (ii) all buses and coaches over 10 tonnes, first registered on or after 1st January 1988, to display a speed limiter plate showing the set speed as 100 km/h

# Water Resources Department of the Environment Department of Agriculture

The Department of the Environment and the Department of Agriculture have made a Statutory Rule entitled The Protection of Water Against Agricultural Nitrate Pollution (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999.

This Rule comes into operation on 1st March, 1999.

The Regulations amend the Protection of Water Against Agricultural Nitrate Pollution Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996, which made provision in relation to European Council Directive 91/676/EEC concerning the protection of waters against pollution caused by nitrates from agricultural sources.

The amendments provide (regulation 2(3)) for reviews and adjustments to nitrate vulnerable zones to be made pursuant to the Regulations rather than by amendment of the Regulations. They also provide (regulation 2(4)) for the code of good agricultural practice to be established pursuant to the Regulations instead of by amendment of the Regulations.

The direction provided that the Company shall cease to be authorised to effect contracts of insurance in general business in the United Kingdom and was given at the request of the Company.
