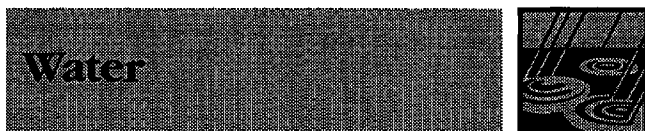

ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF WATERCOURSES 1999/00

The Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland hereby gives notice in pursuance of Regulation 5 (3) of the Drainage (Environmental Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 as amended of proposed routine maintenance works on the main watercourses listed at A below and on minor watercourses in the catchments listed at B below and urban watercourses in the catchments listed at C below and sea defences listed at D below. Further details of the locations along the rivers concerned are available by contacting the Department's Rivers Agency Office at the address below.

The work may include the following:

1. Necessary removal of channel silt and/or aquatic weed growth.
2. Removal of obstructions from the channel which restrict the free flow of water.
3. General maintenance of grilles, culverts, manholes, flap-values and quays.
4. Construction, repair or protection of flood defences, revetments and watercourse structures.
5. Measures for the protection of rehabilitation of fishery, conservation, or other interests.

The Department will carry out the work using environmentally sensitive river engineering techniques.

The Department reserves the right to alter the maintenance programme if required.

Having determined that the proposed works are not, by reason amongst other things of their nature, size or location, likely to have significant environmental effects it is the Department's intention not to prepare an Environmental Statement.

In accordance with Regulation 5 (3) of the Regulations representations may be made in writing to the Department at the address given below, with regard to its intention not to prepare an Environmental Statement. The closing date for receipt of representations is 8th April, 1999.

The Department will consult with Conservation and Fisheries organisations on the works programme.

Angling Waters (Development Schemes) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992

The Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland has received an application under the provisions of the above Scheme from Randalstown Angling Club for the development of game angling on a stretch of the River Main, County Antrim. The Scheme extends for a short distance on the left hand bank of the River Main downstream from within the Kellswater at its confluence with the River Main, more particularly defined in the Scheme.

Whereas the owner of the fishing rights in these waters is unknown or cannot be found, the Department proposes to authorise the development of the derelict waters as defined in accordance with the Scheme submitted by the applicant.

The Scheme will provide for the improvement of waters and the provision of angling facilities.

The Scheme may be inspected at Houston's Tackle Shop, New Street, Randalstown, during normal opening hours.

Before authorising the development of waters, the Department, in pursuance of Section 3 of the Fisheries Act (NI) 1966, as amended, invites any person who claims any right of fishing in the waters or who objects to their development, to notify the grounds of their claim or objection to the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries Division, Annexe 5, Castle Grounds, Stormont Estate, Belfast, BT4 3PW, no later than 2nd April, 1999.

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Economic Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(2) of the Fair Employment and Treatment (Northern Ireland) Order 1998, has made a statutory rule entitled Fair Employment and Treatment (1998 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999.

This Order brings into operation on 1st March, 1999, all the provisions of the Fair Employment and Treatment (Northern Ireland) Order 1998 ("the Order") with the exception of Articles 80 (Effects of certificates by the Secretary of State), 96 and 98. Articles 96 and 98 insert provisions similar to Article 80 in the Sex Discrimination (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 and the Race Relations (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 respectively. Article 105(3), which confers power on the Department of Economic

Development to make transitional is brought into operation on 22nd February, 1999.

The provisions of the Order which require:

- (a) employers in registered private sector concerns with 250 employees or fewer to include details of applicants in monitoring returns;
- (b) employers in registered private sector concerns with more than 250 employees, and employers in all public authorities, to include details of those ceasing to be employed in monitoring returns; and
- (c) employers in any registered concern to monitor those who are in, who apply for or who have ceased to be in part-time employment, will not apply to monitoring returns to be prepared in respect of any year beginning before 1st January, 2001.
