(c) that the product has been heat treated in a hermetically sealed container to a Fo value of 3.0 or more.

All consignments to which this licence refers are subject to the terms of the Products of Animal Origin (Import and Export) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998 and must be made available, if so required for inspection by an officer of the Department. The importer or his agent shall afford all assistance necessary to such an officer to enable him/ her to carry out the inspection.

3. The importer or his agent must immediately notify the local Divisional Veterinary Office of any irregularity in the consignment or accompanying documentation.

4. This licence will remain valid until further notice or unless the licence is revoked by the Department.
