COMMON EXTENSION TERMS

The Department of Finance and Personnel has issued a Direction decreasing from 2.49% to 2.34% per annum the rate of interest on Ulster Savings Certificates to which common extension terms apply.

The new rate will operate and accrue from 1st May, 1999 and until further notice.

The common extension terms apply to Certificates of the National Defence, Supplementary, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Fourteenth, Sixteenth, Eighteenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-first, Twenty-third, Twenty-fourth, Twenty-fifth, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-seventh, Twenty-eighth, Twenty-ninth, Thirtieth, Thirty-first, Thirty-second, Thirty-third, Thirty-fourth, Thirty-fifth, Thirty-sixth, Thirty-seventh, Thirty-eighth, Thirty-ninth, Fortieth and Forty-first Issues.

The common extension terms were introduced by regulations made on 15th June, 1982 (S.R. 1982 No. 178).

Notice is given that the Department of the Environment made on 28th April, 1999, the Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999 (S.R. 1999 No. 206) which came into operation on 3rd May, 1999. The purpose of the Order is to—
introduce charging on a Wednesday and amend the tariff applicable in the car parks at Dobbin Street Lane, Friary Road (East Side), Linenhall Street and Mall West, Armagh, Castle Lane and Moore's Lane, Lurgan, Canal Bank II, Lower Water Street, Mill Street and Monaghan Street, Newry;

introduce charging on a Thursday and amend the tariff applicable in the car parks at Commercial Road, Downshire Place and Kenlis Street, Banbridge and Magowan Buildings II, Meadow Lane East and Meadow Lane West, Portadown;

introduce charging Monday to Saturday in the car parks at Church Street, Downpatrick, Queen's Road, Lisburn, Canal Bank III, Newry, Upper Court Street, Newtownards and Marley Street, Portadown;
