Notice is given that the Department of the Environment has made – on 21st May, 1999, a Direction to continue in force the Experimental Traffic Control Scheme –

Prohibition of Use by Through Traffic of Elmwood and Beechmount Parks, Newry for a period of 6 months from 24th May, 1999; on 24th May, 1999, an Order entitled Motorway M1 (Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999 (S.R. 1999 No. 240) which will come into operation on 1st June, 1999. The Order reduces the speed limit on part of the citybound carriageway and adjoining hard shoulder of the Motorway M1, on the citybound on-slip road from Junction 2 (Stockman's Lane) to the Motorway M1, and on the off-slip road from the Motorway M1 to Donegall Road, Belfast from 70 mph to 50 mph. on 25th May, 1999, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article

13 of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 an Order entitled Off-Street Parking (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999 (S.R. 1999 No. 243) which will come into operation on 5th July, 1999. The effect of the Order is to revise the charges applicable in the car park at Market Yard, Strabane, and details of the charges before and after the Order comes into operation (columns A and B respectively) are set out below.

ROUTE C271 BEECHVALE ROAD, KILLINCHY (No. 2)

ROUTE U1122 DRENNAN'S ROAD, ALDERGROVE

- 1. Landing must take place at either the Port of Larne, Belfast Port or Ballycastle Harbour.
- 2. During transport the imported animals must not come into contact with animals that are not of the same health status. The animals must be transported in vehicles which have been cleansed and disinfected before use.
- 3. One working day's advance notice of importation must be given to the Department of Agriculture official at the destination slaughter premises, including the total number of animals to be imported.
- 4. The animals to be imported must be clearly and permanently identified by means of a tattoo and/or ear tag which permits tracing of their premises of origin and an indelible mark on their heads which identifies them as animals for slaughter.
- 5. The animals to be imported must be accompanied by a valid health certificate and a schedule giving details of the ear numbers, breed, sex and age of the animals to which it relates and the registration number of the vehicle in which the animals are being transported to Northern Ireland. The health certificate and schedule must be signed by a Local Veterinary Inspector appointed by the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.
- 6. The health certificate referred to at paragraph 5 above must certify that, within 24 hours of the time of loading all the pigs described in the schedule of the certificate were clinically examined, their identification marks were seen to be clear and as stated in the schedule, they were found to be free from any evidence of infectious or contagious disease including ectoparasitism and were in all respects healthy and fit to travel.
- 7. Immediately after landing, the imported animals must be taken direct to the destination slaughter premises in Northern Ireland without coming into contact with any other animals. At the slaughter premises, the imported animals plus the health certificate(s) which accompanied the animals must be presented to an officer of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland. In the absence of an officer of the Department, the health certificate(s) must be presented to an employee of the destination slaughter premises for transmission to the said officer.
- 8. Imported pigs must be presented to an officer of the Department for checking on the slaughter premises if required.
- This licence is valid until further notice or unless the licence is revoked by the Department.
