Notice Of Intention To Make An Abandonment Order Route B101 Killead Road, Aldergrove

The Department for Regional Development being of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic proposes to make an order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 the effect of which would be to abandon a length of approximately 103 metres of superseded Route B101 Killead Road, Aldergrove in the townland of Killealy and County of Antrim to the front of No 60 Killead Road and extending in a north-easterly direction.

The Belfast-Larne Trunk Road T9 (Ballynure)

The Department for Regional Development hereby gives notice in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 8 to the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 that it proposes to make an order under Articles 14(1) and 68(1) and (3) of the said Roads Order.
