SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE (IRELAND) ACT, 1877.

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date it is proposed to submit to His Grace the Governor and Privy Council of Northern Ireland Rules of Court substituting new Rules for the Rules of Orders LXXIV and LXXV of the Rules of the Supreme Court (Ireland), 1905, as altered by an Order of the 27th day of June, 1910, in respect of their application to Northern Ireland.

WHEREAS by the Dangerous Drugs Act (Northern Ireland), 1932, the Dangerous Drugs Acts (Northern Ireland), 1920 to 1925, were amended so far as was necessary

to assimilate the law in Northern Ireland to the law in force in Great Britain in relation to certain dangerous drugs and drugs capable of being converted into dangerous drugs, and it was enacted by Section 5 (3) of the said Act that the said Act should, as respects any particular provision thereof, come into operation as from such date as the Governor of Northern Ireland might by Order in Council appoint, having regard to the date appointed by His Majesty by Order in Council for the coming into operation of any provision of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1932 (passed by the Parliament of the United Kingdom):

And Whereas His Majesty in pursuance of the powers conferred on Him, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, was pleased by Order in Council on the 25th day of May, 1933, to appoint that the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1932, should come into operation on the 9th day of July, 1933:
