- Provision of a new partial grade-separated interchange, with southbound exit ramp and northbound entry ramp, located in the vicinity of Feede Cross.

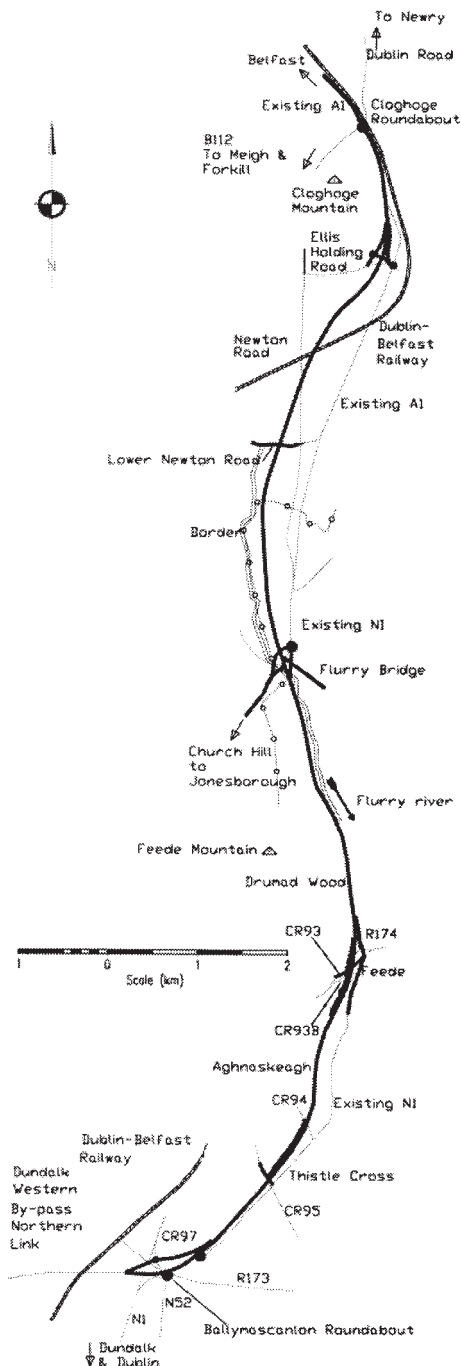

The Statutory Rule brings into operation a Labour Relations Agency Code of Practice on Redundancy Consultation and Procedures which is a revision of the Code of Practice on Redundancy Consultation and Procedures previously issued by the Agency on 9th September 1998. The revised Code of Practice takes account of changes to the legislative provisions on consultation on collective redundancies as a consequence of the enactment of the Collective Redundancies and Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) (Amendment) Regulations (NI) 1999. Some further amendments of a minor and technical nature have also been made and a number of statutory provisions updated.

The Code of Practice was approved by the Northern Ireland Assembly on 14th October, 2002 and the above-named Appointed Day Order (Statutory Rule) which was subject to the negative resolution procedure, brought the Code into operation on 1st December, 2002.
