## Armagh Area Plan 2018 Notice of Intention to Prepare a Development Plan

The Plan will be prepared within the context of the Regional Development Strategy. #### THE INDUSTRIAL POLLUTION CONTROL (PRESCRIBED PROCESSES AND SUBSTANCES)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2003

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 3(1) to 4 of the Industrial Pollution Control (Northern Ireland) Order 1997, The Department of the Environment has made the Industrial Pollution Control (Prescribed Processes and Substances)(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003.

The Regulations also amend the 1998 Regulations so that (a) petrol terminals with throughputs of less than 10,000 tonnes per year are prescribed for local (district council) control, and (b) the date of authorisation of petrol terminals with throughputs of less than 25,000 tonnes per year is now 31st December, 2004.

The Rule comes into operation on 17th April 2003.

The Rule is made under Article 5 of the Water (Northern Ireland) Order 1999.

These Regulations amend the Surface Waters (Fishlife) (Classification) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997 ("the principal Regulations").

Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations allows for the sampling of waters classified under those Regulations to be reduced in frequency or dispensed with in certain circumstances. Regulation 2 of these Regulations clarified that regulation by setting out the circumstances in which sampling may be reduced or dispensed with. Should those circumstances change, the decision to reduce or discontinue sampling must be revisited.

These Regulations, together with the principal Regulations, transpose in part the requirements of Directive 78/659/EEC on the quality of fresh waters needing protection and improvement in order to support fish life in relation to Northern Ireland (OJ No. L222, 14.08.78, p. 1).

The Department of the Environment has made a Statutory Rule entitled **the Marketing and Use of Dangerous Substances (No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 (S.R. 2003 No. 165)**.

The Rule comes into operation on 28th April, 2003.

The Rule gives effect to European Council Directive 1991/338/EEC amending for the 10th time Commission Directive 76/769/EEC on the approximation of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations.

The Rule which is made under section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, restricts the marketing and use of cadmium and its compounds. It prohibits the use of cadmium to give colour to finished products made from certain plastics; imposes marketing restrictions in relation to levels of cadmium permitted in certain paints; prohibits the use of cadmium to stabilise certain finished products made from PVC, and the marketing of such products; and prohibits the use in the metallic plating of certain products, and the marketing of those products so plated. The Rule makes it a criminal offence to do so and specifies penalties for such an offence.
