PUBLICATION OF THE PUBLIC CONSULTATION REPORT ON THE BELFAST METROPOLITAN AREA PLAN (BMAP) 2015

The Department of Environment published the "Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan 2015 – Issues Paper" on 7th December 2001, for the purposes of public consultation and participation on a wide range of key issues likely to influence the shape of future development within the Plan area. In order to assist the debate and facilitate response, the Department appointed consultants PricewaterhouseCoopers, in association with staff from Queen's University and the Urban Institute, to undertake a comprehensive and wide-ranging public and community consultation on the Issues Paper, during the period January-March 2002. This process involved holding a series of information meetings across the Plan area, followed by a more extensive series of public consultation meetings, at which issues were discussed and debated in an open forum. The consultation process also involved a number of targeted focus groups and workshops.

The Report on Public Consultation sets out the views and opinions expressed during the consultation process, and will help inform the development of the Draft Plan.
