THE SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT (LETTERS PATENT AND PROCLAMATIONS) ORDER 1999

The following Letters Patent were signed by Her Majesty The Queen on the 5th May 2004 in respect of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Bill asp 4.

ELIZABETH THE SECOND by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories Queen Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament.

GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of

the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

In Witness Whereof we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.

Proposal for a draft Anti-Social Behaviour (Northern Ireland) Order 2004

On 10th May 2004 the Northern Ireland Office undertook a public consultation on the provisions contained in a draft proposal for an Anti-Social Behaviour (Northern Ireland) Order 2004.

The proposed draft Order provides:

- For the introduction of anti-social behaviour orders (ASBOs) as a statutory measure in Northern Ireland, with the aim of protecting the public from behaviour that causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress;

- that in circumstances where there is no associated conviction the police, the relevant District Council or the Northern Ireland Housing Executive would be entitled to apply to a magistrates court for an ASBO in respect of a person who has been acting in an anti-social manner where such an order is necessary to protect relevant persons from further anti-social acts by him;
 - That ASBOs may also be made on conviction in criminal proceedings, where the court is satisfied that there is evidence of anti-social behaviour on the part of the convicted person and that an ASBO is necessary to protect persons within Northern Ireland from further anti-social acts by him; and
 - That breach of an ASBO would be a criminal offence subject to a penalty of up to five years imprisonment or a fine or both.

PATERNITY AND ADOPTION LEAVE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2004 (SR 2004 No. 116)

Notice is hereby given that the Department for Employment and Learning, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 107A(7), 107B(8) and 107D(1) of the Employment Rights (Northern Ireland) Order 1996, and now invested in it, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, has made a Statutory Rule entitled the Paternity and Adoption Leave (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004 (SR 2004 No. 116).

These Regulations amend provisions relating to adoption leave in the Paternity and Adoption Leave Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002 ("the Principal Regulations"). Regulation 3 removes the provision enabling an employer to request the name and date of birth of a child in respect of whom leave is taken (regulation 17(3) of the Principal Regulations). Regulation 4 amends regulation 27 of the Principal Regulations to provide that all terms and conditions applying in relation to an employee returning to work from adoption leave, not just those relating to remuneration, are to be not less favourable than those which would have applied if the employee had not been absent.

The Regulations came into operation on 6th April 2004.

STATUTORY PATERNITY PAY AND STATUTORY ADOPTION PAY (WEEKLY RATES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2004 (SR 2004 No. 111)

These Regulations substitute a new regulation 2 into the Statutory Paternity Pay and Statutory Adoption Pay (Weekly Rates) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002 with the effect that any week of paternity leave beginning on or after 4th April 2004 will be paid at the new rate.
