The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991

The Belfast Houses in Multiple Occupation Subject Plan 2015 is being prepared under the provisions of Part III of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 by the Planning Service, an Agency within the Department of the Environment. The Subject Plan will be in addition to the ongoing Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan, which was published in draft form in November 2004. The Subject Plan will be prepared within the context of the Regional Development Strategy. It will inform the general public, statutory authorities, developers and other interested bodies of the policy framework and proposals that will be used to guide development decisions relating to Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs) in Belfast City Council area.

On Monday15th August 2005 the Department will publish the "Belfast HMO Subject Plan 2015 – Issues Paper" for the purposes of public consultation and participation. In order to promote an inclusive consultation process one or more events may take place at which

members of the public or other interested parties may be able to participate in order to comment and discuss the issues.
