The following Letters Patent were signed by Her Majesty The Queen on the **13th of December 2005** in respect of the **Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Bill asp 15**

ELIZABETH THE SECOND by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories Queen Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith To Our trusty and well beloved the members of the Scottish Parliament GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.

Publication of Draft Plan and Public Display

The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991

The Craigavon Town Centre Boundaries and Retail Designations Plan 2010 is a development plan being prepared under the provisions of Part III of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 by the Planning Service, an Agency within the Department of the Environment. The Plan relates to the town centres of Central Craigavon, Lurgan and Portadown and its purpose is to inform the general public, statutory authorities, developers and other interested bodies of the policy framework that will be used to guide retail development decisions within the three town centres.

The Department for Regional Development has determined, in accordance with Article 28(3) of the Planning (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 2003, that the Draft Craigavon Town Centre Boundaries and Retail Designations Plan is in general conformity with the Regional Development Strategy for Northern Ireland 2025. This statement of general conformity may be inspected during normal office hours at the Divisional Planning Office, Craigavon from 9.30am on Tuesday 20 December 2005.

Following the consideration of representations made in accordance with Article 5(3) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, the Department has now prepared and is publishing the Draft Craigavon Town Centre Boundaries and Retail Designations Plan 2010 on Tuesday 20 December 2005, consisting of a written statement and accompanying maps. The Draft Plan will be on public display at the Divisional Planning Office, Craigavon between 9.30am and 5.00pm from Tuesday 20 December 2005 to Tuesday 14 February 2006, with the exception of public holidays.
