## Belvoir Road & Newtownbreda Road, Belfast: Stopping Up

The Department for Regional Development gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993, the effect of which would be to stop-up the following lengths of roads to road traffic upon the completion of works providing alternative facilities for that traffic:

- The south-eastern side of the south-eastern carriageway of Belvoir Road, Belfast at a line from a point 179.5 metres north-east of its junction with Dunseverick Avenue to a point 211.2 metres northeast of that junction.
- The north-western side of Newtownbreda Road, Belfast, at a line from a point 404.4 metres south-west of its junction with Beechill Road to a point 432.5 metres south-west of that junction.
- Newtownbreda Road, Belfast, at a line from a point on its south-eastern side 384 metres south-west of its junction with Beechill Road to a point on its north-western side 418 metres south-west of that junction.
- Newtownbreda Road, Belfast, at a line from a point on its northwestern side 274 metres south-west of its junction with Beechill Road to a point on its south-eastern side 292 metres south-west of that junction.

The roads to be stopped-up are delineated on maps which together with a copy of a draft Order may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable times during the period from 1st February 2006 and 13th March 2006 at the Department's Roads Service offices, Headquarters, Room 201, Clarence Court, 10 – 18 Adelaide Street, Belfast BT2 8GB; and Eastern Division, Hydebank, 4 Hospital Road, Belfast BT8 8JL.

Any person may within the said period object to the proposal by written notice to Roads Service Headquarters at the address above stating the grounds of objection.
