- (a) The Authority proposes, pursuant to its power under Articles 14(1)(a) and 14(1)(b) of the Order, to make modifications to conditions contained in each of the gas conveyance licences granted under Article 8(1)(a) of the Order to -
  - (i) Bord Gais Eireann (and subsequently assigned to BGE (UK) Ltd);
  - (ii) Phoenix Natural Gas Limited; and
  - (iii) Premier Transmission Limited. (the "licensees")
- 2 It is proposed that the modifications will become effective on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2006.

**Reasons**

- 3 The modifications are being made to:
  - (a) clarify a number of issues surrounding the "Postalisation" processes and procedures;
  - (b) ensure consistency between the "Postalisation" provisions and other provisions in the licences; and
  - (c) avoid discrepancies and inconsistency between the PSA and the licensees in calculating certain charges.

**Effect**

- 4 The proposed modifications will:
  - (a) define GS Firm Capacity by reference to months;
  - (b) place certain limits on the Forecast Postalised Commodity Charge and the Forecast Postalised Capacity Charge;
  - (c) provide for termination payments to be accounted for in the Year End Charges and in the Year End Amount Formula;
  - (d) take into account whether gas suppliers have received debt repayments;
  - (e) make explicit that the PSA is also to receive the Forecast Required Revenues (FRR) from the licensees; and
  - (f) requires the licensees to submit their FRRs for the forthcoming five years.

**THE EMPLOYMENT OF CHILDREN (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2006 No 212**

Regulation 2 replaces regulation 3 of the Employment of Children Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996, ("the principal Regulations")

placing a limit on the number of hours that a child may be employed in any week in which he is required to attend school.

Regulations 3 and 4 amend regulations 4(b) and 5(b) respectively of the principal Regulations to clarify that the restriction on the number of hours worked by children in these circumstances relates to any week when children are not required to attend school.

Regulation 5 replaces regulation 6 of the principal Regulations, removing the requirement to submit a medical certificate to the appropriate education and library board.

Regulation 6 amends regulation 8 of the principal Regulations making changes consequential upon the substitution of regulation 6 of the principal Regulations.

### **THE PLANNING (NATIONAL SECURITY DIRECTIONS AND APPOINTED REPRESENTATIVES) RULES (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2006**

Article 123A of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 provides that, at any inquiry or independent examination held under the Order, oral evidence is to be heard in public and documentary evidence to be open to public inspection except where the Secretary of State otherwise directs on the grounds that the public disclosure of information relating to national security or to measures intended to secure premises or property would be contrary to the public interest. The Article provides for the appointment of persons ("appointed representatives") to represent the interests of any person who will be prevented from hearing or inspecting any evidence at a public local inquiry or independent examination if such a direction is given.
