The Craigavon Town Centre Boundaries and Retail Designations Plan 2010 is a development plan being prepared under Part III of the Planning (NI) Order 1991 by the Planning Service, an Agency within the Department of the Environment relating to the Central Craigavon, Lurgan and Portadown town centres.

The Draft Plan with its supporting documents was published on 20th December 2005 and made available for public inspection.
