Workers will be eligible to 5.6 weeks from 1 April 2009. The statutory minimum holiday entitlement is capped at 28 days. The additional entitlement may not be replaced by a payment in lieu except where the employment is terminated or during the transitional period between 1 October 2007 and 31 March 2009.
