The procedure for such applications is contained in new rules 3.40 to 3.46.

Rule 5.1 of the 1996 Rules is also amended to provide for appeals in respect of a forced marriage protection order from a designated county court to the Court of Appeal.

The amendments shall come into operation on 22nd December 2008.

THE VICTIMS OF MENTALLY DISORDERED OFFENDERS INFORMATION (NORTHERN IRELAND) SCHEME 2008

The Secretary of State for Northern Ireland has made the Victims of Mentally Disordered Offenders Information (Northern Ireland) Scheme 2008 in exercise of the powers conferred by section 69A of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002.

The Scheme comes into operation on 15 December 2008.

The purpose of the Scheme is to put in place a mechanism whereby if an offence results in the making of a hospital order with a restriction order, or a transfer direction with a restriction direction in respect of the offender, the victim of that offender should have access to information about the offender's discharge from hospital, or grant of leave from hospital and information as to any relevant conditions to which the offender is to be made subject to in the event of the offender's discharge or leave of absence from hospital. The Scheme also provides for the victim to make representations to the Secretary of State about whether the offender should be subject to any conditions in the event of discharge or grant of leave of absence from hospital and if so, what conditions.

The Order also brings into operation on 5th January 2009 the provisions set out in Part III of the Schedule regarding the seizure and retention of

vehicles used in a manner causing alarm, distress or annoyance.

Finally, the Order also brings into operation on 2nd February 2009 provisions set out in Part IV of the Schedule regarding live links in court proceedings.

The Secretary of State for Northern Ireland has also made the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2008 in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 1(3) of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004.

The Order comes into operation on 2nd February 2009 and brings into operation the provisions of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2004 set out in the Schedule relating to live links in criminal proceedings.
