The Rules of the Supreme Court (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) 2009 [S.R. 2009 No. 207]

These Rules amend the Rules of the Supreme Court (Northern Ireland) 1980 (S.R. 1980 No. 346) in consequence of:

- amendments made by the Counter Terrorism Act 2008 to the Terrorism Act 2000 (“the 2000 Act”) in relation to when a restraint order may be made. Rule 3(1) amends Order 116 to reflect the circumstances in which a restraint order may be made under the 2000 Act as amended;
- amendments made by the Serious Crime Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”) to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (“the 2002 Act”) in relation to civil recovery management receivers and detained cash investigations; and by the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (External Requests and Orders) (Amendment) Order 2008 to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 (External Requests and Orders) Order 2005 in relation to civil recovery management receivers. Rule 3(2) amends Order 123 to include provision for the procedure to be followed in applying for a management receiving order and for applications relating to the exercise of management receivers powers under the 2002 Act as amended;
- the 2007 Act in relation to serious crime prevention orders. Rule 3(3) inserts a new Order 124 which prescribes the practice and procedure to be used in proceedings under Part 1 of the 2007 Act in relation to the making, variation, discharge and appeal of serious crime prevention orders made by the High Court;
- Rule 3(4) makes amendments to Forms 27 and 72 in Appendix A in connection with these Rules.

### **THE CRIMINAL APPEAL (SERIOUS CRIME PREVENTION ORDERS) RULES (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2009 [S.R. 2009 No. 208]**

Notice is hereby given that the Northern Ireland Supreme Court Rules Committee has made the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by section 55 and 55A of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978 and the Lord Chancellor has allowed them.

The Criminal Appeal (Serious Crime Prevention Orders) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2009 [S.R. 2009 No. 208]

These Rules make provision for applications to the Court of Appeal in relation to appeals under section 24 of the Serious Crime Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”) and Parts 5 and 6 of the Serious Crime Act 2007 (Appeals under section 24) Order 2008 (“the 2008 Order”).

Section 24 of the 2007 Act provides that a person who is the subject of a serious crime prevention order, or the Director of Public Prosecutions may appeal to the Court of Appeal against a decision of the Crown Court in relation to that order. In addition, any person who was given an opportunity to make representations in the proceedings by virtue of section 9(4) of the 2007 Act may appeal to the Court of Appeal against a decision of the Crown Court to make, vary or not vary a serious crime prevention order.

In particular, the Rules;

- prescribe procedure in relation to giving notice of appeal or an application for leave to appeal under section 24 of the 2007 Act;
- make provision in relation to the provision of notes, documents and exhibits (excepting transcripts) from the original proceedings;
- make provision in relation to applications that can be heard by the Master or a single judge of the Court of Appeal, and in relation to applications by aggrieved parties for decisions arising from those applications to be determined by the full Court;
- prescribe the procedure for making an application to the Court of Appeal for leave to appeal to the House of Lords under Part 6 of the 2008 Order; and
- prescribe procedure governing the abandonment of proceedings by the applicant.

These Rules will come into operation on 30th June 2009.
