THE ELECTRICITY AND GAS BILLING REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2009

Notice is hereby given that, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972, the Department has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Electricity and Gas Billing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009. The Regulations transpose, for Northern Ireland, EU Directive 2006/32/EC on energy end-use efficiency and energy services which entered into force on 17 May 2006 and also to give effect to Article 13 of EC Regulation No.1775/2005.

These Regulations implement Article 13 3 (b) of the Energy End Use Efficiency and Energy Services Directive and require suppliers of electricity and gas in Northern Ireland to provide domestic consumers with historical consumption information on their bills or statements of accounts. The information required is a comparison of customer's energy or gas consumption covered by the period of the bill or statement with that for the corresponding period in the previous year.

In addition these regulations also give effect to Article 13 Regulation EC No. 1775/2005 by adding the Regulation to the definition of 'relevant requirements' under the financial penalty power contained within Article 45(1) and Article 45(11) of The Energy (Northern Ireland) Order 2003. The Regulation aims to set non-discriminatory rules for access conditions to natural gas transmission systems taking into account the specificities of national and regional markets with a view to ensuring the proper functioning of the internal gas market. In particular Article 13 requires that member states both establish provisions to penalise infringements of the Regulation and 'take all necessary measures to ensure that the penalties are implemented'
