#### WHEAT BYELAWS, 1932.

WHEAT (FLOUR MIXTURES) No. 1 BYELAW, 1935.

1. Byelaw 19 of the Wheat Byelaws, 1932, shall have effect as if there were included among the mixtures to which that Byelaw applies, the following mixtures, that is to say:—

Sunvico, Sunvilene, Milalene, Golden Milalene.

2. This Byelaw may be cited as the Wheat (Flour Mixtures) No. 1 Byelaw, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Wheat Byelaws, 1932.

The above Byelaw has been duly made by the Wheat Commission in the exercise of their powers under the Wheat Act, 1932.
