Whereas, We consider it desirable that Monday the second day of January, Monday the seventh day of May and Tuesday the fifth day of June in the year 2012 should be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland;

And whereas, to mark, the Sixtieth Anniversary of Our Accession to the Throne, it appears to Us that it is inexpedient that Monday the twenty-eighth day of May in the year 2012 should be a bank holiday in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and We consider it desirable that Monday the fourth day of June in the year 2012 should be appointed a bank holiday in England, Wales and Northern Ireland in place of it:

And whereas, We consider it desirable that Thursday the twelfth day of July in the year 2012 should be a bank holiday in Northern Ireland:

And whereas it appears to Us that it is inexpedient that Saturday, the seventeenth day of March in the year 2012 should be a bank holiday in Northern Ireland and We consider it desirable that Monday the nineteenth day of March in the year 2012 should be appointed a bank holiday in Northern Ireland in place of it:

Now, therefore, We in pursuance of section 1(2) and section 1(3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Monday the second day of January, Monday the seventh day of May, Monday the fourth day of June and Tuesday the fifth day of June in the year 2012 to be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and appoint Monday the nineteenth day of March and Thursday the twelfth day of July in the year 2012 to be bank holidays in Northern Ireland.

#### TRUNK ROAD ORDER

#### THE M1/TRUNK ROAD T3 (MOTORWAY SERVICE AREA) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2011

The Department for Regional Development hereby gives notice in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 8 to the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 that it proposes to make an order under Articles 14(1), 15(1) and 16(1) and (2) of that Order.

The proposed Order will provide that—

439 metres of new slip roads in the townlands of Tullynacross and Ballyskeagh and County of Down consisting of:

- (a) 99 metres of slip road adjacent to the Belfast bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally north-easterly direction from a point on the M1 718 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge;
- (b) 144 metres of slip road adjacent to the Belfast bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally north-easterly direction from a point on the M1 966 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge;
- (c) 161 metres of slip road adjacent to the Dungannon bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally south-westerly direction from a point on the M1 700 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge; and
- (d) 35 metres of slip road adjacent to the Dungannon bound carriageway of the M1 motorway extending in a generally south-westerly direction from a point on the M1 1010 metres north-east of the centre point of Tullynacross Bridge,

shall be special roads subject to motorway traffic restrictions and be part of the Belfast-Ballygawley-Londonderry-Land Frontier Trunk Road T3.

The proposals are delineated on a map which, together with a copy of the draft Order, may be inspected, by any person free of charge, at all reasonable hours during the period from 8 June 2011 to 22 July 2011 at the Roads Service offices of the Department, Eastern Division, Hydebank, 4 Hospital Road, Belfast; Headquarters, Room 2-13, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast; and at the offices of Lisburn City Council, Civic Centre, Lagan Valley Island, 1 The Island, Lisburn.

#### THE POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2011

The Department of the Environment has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Pollution Prevention and Control (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011 (S.R.2011 No. 212), which comes into operation on 25 June 2011.

The Rule transposes Article 37 of Directive 2009/31/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the geological storage of carbon dioxide, and makes some minor amendments to the Pollution Prevention and Control Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003.

#### THE WELFARE REFORM (2010 ACT) (COMMENCEMENT NO. 3) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2011

This Commencement Order brings in Section 26 of the Welfare Reform Act (Northern Ireland) 2010. Section 26 provides the main legislative authority for the changes to the contracting out functions under the Jobseekers (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 (the 1995 Order). Section 26(1) amends the 1995 Order and section 26(2) inserts a new Article 22E into that Order. Article 22E of the 1995 Order allows the Department to make regulations which enable persons to exercise functions of the Department and the Department for Employment and Learning.

In accordance with regulation 3(2) of the above Regulations, notice is hereby given that the Department has carried out a sensitive area review of surface water bodies for the period 2006 to 2009.

The review supports the existing identifications and recommends that these remain in place. One additional identification has been made at Ballyholme bathing water. This water is to be identified as a sensitive area effective from 17 June 2011.

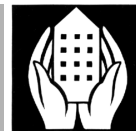
