BOOT AND SHOE REPAIRING TRADE BOARD (NORTHERN IRELAND)

The Trade Board established under the powers vested in the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, and in pursuance of Section 8 of the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, and the Enactments modified and adapted by the Government of Ireland (Adaptation of Enactments), (No. 3) Order, 1921, and any

other Order of His Majesty in Council made under the said Act of 1920 for those branches of the Boot and Shoe Repairing Trade defined in the Regulations of the said Ministry, dated 2nd day of January, 1922, Hereby Give Notice that they propose to vary minimum rates of wages for Male and Female Workers.

On request to the Trade Board particulars of the proposed minimum rates and information as to their application will be given, if, in the opinion of the Trade Board, the applicant is likely to be affected thereby.
