The Rule will abandon an area of 955 square metres of road at the entrance to Norbrook Laboratories Ltd, Carnbane Industrial Estate, Newry.

The Department for Regional Development has made a Statutory Rule entitled *The Browning Drive, Londonderry (Abandonment) Order 2012* (S.R. 2012 No.211) which comes into operation on 4 July 2012.

The Rule will abandon an area of 393 square metres of road at the western end of Browning Drive, Londonderry, adjacent to the railway line. (6)

STOPPING-UP ORDER

The Department for Regional Development has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Durham Street and Hamill Street – Killen Street, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No.196) which comes into operation on 4 July 2012.

The Rule will stop-up to vehicular traffic:

WAITING RESTRICTIONS**LISBURN**

The Department for Regional Development has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Waiting Restrictions (Lisburn) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 195) which will come into operation on 7th June 2012.

The rule introduces a 'no waiting at any time' restriction at Finch Gardens, Lisburn. (8)

PENALTY CHARGES

The Department for Regional Development has made a Statutory Rule entitled The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 203) which will come into operation on 4th July 2012.

The Rule will amend The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006 by increasing the penalty charges for road traffic offences subject to civil enforcement from £60.00 to £90.00.

CONTROL OF TRAFFIC**BELFAST CITY CENTRE**

The Department for Regional Development has made the following Statutory Rules on 17th May 2012 which will come into operation on 8th June 2012.

The Control of Traffic (Belfast City Centre) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 197) will introduce one-way contra flow cycle lanes, a two-way cycle lane, one-way traffic systems and other traffic measures in Belfast City Centre.

The Bus Lanes (Belfast City Centre) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 198) will provide for bus lanes on lengths of various roads in Belfast City Centre. The bus lanes will operate 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday in which motor cycles, cycles and permitted taxis will be permitted.

The Waiting Restrictions (Belfast City Centre) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 199) will prohibit vehicles waiting on various lengths of road in Belfast City Centre. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

The Cycle Routes (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 200) will introduce two-way cycle tracks on lengths of roads in Belfast City Centre.

The Parking Places on Roads (Coaches) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 201) will authorise the use as parking places for coaches lengths of Donegall Square West, High Street and College Square North, Belfast. The Rule also revokes and replaces with amendments the Parking Places on Roads (Coaches) Order (Northern Ireland) 1997.

The Parking Places on Roads (Belfast City Centre) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 (S.R. 2012 No. 202) will authorise the use as parking places (including a parking place requiring a permit, loading bays and bays for disabled persons' vehicles) of various lengths of road in Belfast City Centre and prescribe the conditions under which they can be used. Vehicles are excepted from the conditions in certain circumstances.

PARKING PLACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES

- The Order creates parking places for the use of disabled persons' vehicles at **Armagh**: Drumbreda Crescent; **Belfast**: Blythe Street; City Walk; Eblana Street; Pretoria Street; Ponsonby Avenue; Ulsterville Gardens; Wallasey Park; **Belleek**: Main Street; **Dundonald**: Enler Park East; **Enniskillen**: Fairview Lane; Windmill Heights; Lisnaskea: Lower Main Street; **Londonderry**: Westend Park; William Street; **Magherafelt**: Highfield Road; **Newcastle**: Church Avenue, Dundrum (2 bays); **Newry**: O'Neill Avenue; **Newtownards**: Park Crescent and **Portadown**: South Street.; and bays with **waiting limited** to 3 hours, Monday to Saturday 8.30 a.m. and 6.15 p.m. (no return within 1 hour) at **Lurgan**: Church Place; Market Street; and a bay with **waiting limited** to 2 hours, Monday to Saturday 8.30 a.m. and 6.15 p.m. (no return within 3 hours) in **Newry**: Monaghan Street.; and also the **removal** of the parking places at **Bangor**: Southwell Road; **Belfast**: Pomona Avenue; **Cookstown**: Orritor Crescent; **Holywood**: Ardlee Avenue; **Portadown**: Hanover Street.

All parking places are for the use of disabled persons' vehicles only.

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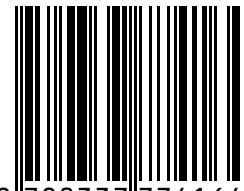
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
