Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND PERSONNEL HAS MADE A STATUTORY RULE ENTITLED "THE BUILDING (PRESCRIBED FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2013" (S.R. 2013 NO. 60).

These Regulations amend the Building (Prescribed Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997 and the purpose of the amendment is to:

- increase fee charges by 20% for mainly domestic building applications, but for applications consisting of 10 dwellings or more, this increase would gradually reduce to 11.5% where the application consists of 20 or more dwellings;
- introduce an optional "type approval" fee where the applicant may wish to build the same dwelling type in more than one district council area;
- introduce a 50% "plan fee" discount when plans for a development containing "type approved" dwellings are deposited with an individual council (where this approval route is adopted by an applicant, savings in fee charges would apply from the second deposit);
- set specific fee amounts for works for fixed building services, e.g heating installations and renewable technologies, so that these fees relate to the district council involvement rather than currently to the cost of the installation (a reduction in fee charges);
- require payment of fees due to a district council before a completion certificate is issued; and
- make minor administrative and procedural revisions to reflect recent changes to the Building Regulations which came into operation on 31 October 2012.

These Regulations come into operation on 8th April 2013, but do not apply in relation to work which has been completed, or for which plans have been deposited with a district council, before that date.

The Office of Fair Trading (OFT) hereby gives general notice pursuant to section 234A(4) of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (FSMA) of a determination made by the Financial Ombudsman Service Limited (FOS) with the approval of the Financial Services Authority (FSA). The Determination was made pursuant to section 234A(1) of FSMA and determines that the sum of £1,575,000 is to be raised by way of contributions for the period ending 31 March 2014 for the purpose of funding the operation of the ombudsman scheme so far as it relates to the consumer credit jurisdiction. Such sum includes collection costs of £75,000 but excludes any value added tax.

Contributions

2. Further, for the purpose of raising the sum of £1,575,000 referred to in paragraph 1 above and subject to the exceptions referred to in paragraph 4 below, the OFT, by general notice pursuant to section 234A(5) of FSMA herein imposes requirements as described in paragraph 3 on persons who make applications for a standard consumer credit licence or for the renewal of a standard consumer credit licence ('applicant' or 'applicants'), and on holders of standard licences which have effect indefinitely, where the standard licensee's payment period ends on any date between 5 April 2013 and 31 March 2014 (inclusive) ('licensees').

Requirements

3. Unless applicants or licensees fall within any of the exceptions set down in paragraph 4, below, they are required to pay a contribution of £140 ('the contribution') to the OFT. For applicants, the contribution must accompany the application to the OFT for a standard consumer credit licence or for the renewal of a standard consumer credit licence ('the application'). For licensees, the contribution must accompany the maintenance charge paid pursuant to s28A(1) Consumer Credit Act 1974.
