### CEREMONIAL.

OBSERVED AT THE RECEPTION AND SWEARING IN OF HIS GRACE, JAMES ALBERT EDWARD, DUKE OF ABERCORN, AS GOVERNOR OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

12th December, 1922.

His Grace, the Duke of Abercorn, was received on his arrival at the Courts of Justice, Belfast, by the Prime Minister of Northern Ireland and the Members of the Cabinet of Northern Ireland, and conducted to the Court House, where His Grace's Warrant of Appointment as Governor of Northern Ireland was presented to the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland.

After the Royal Warrant of Appointment had been read by the Prime Minister of Northern Ireland, the Oath of Allegiance and

the Official Oath were administered to His Grace by the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland.

His Grace took and subscribed the Oath of Allegiance and the Official Oath and proceeded with the Prime Minister and the Members of the Cabinet of Northern Ireland to hold a meeting of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland.
