GREETING:

FORASMUCH as a Bill has been passed by the Scottish Parliament and has been submitted to Us for Our Royal Assent by the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament in accordance with the Scotland Act 1998 the short Title of which Bill is set forth in the Schedule hereto but that Bill by virtue of the Scotland Act 1998 does not become an

Act of the Scottish Parliament nor have effect in the Law without Our Royal Assent signified by Letters Patent under Our Scottish Seal (that is Our Seal appointed by the Treaty of Union to be kept and used in Scotland in place of the Great Seal of Scotland) signed with Our own hand and recorded in the Register of the Great Seal We have therefore caused these Our Letters Patent to be made and have signed them and by them do give Our Royal Assent to that Bill COMMANDING ALSO the Keeper of Our Scottish Seal to seal these Our Letters with that Seal.

BLUE BADGE SCHEME – CONSULTATION

The Department for Regional Development (DRD) has published a consultation document on its proposal for changes to the Blue Badge Scheme.

The consultation document contains a number of planned and potential changes to the Blue Badge Scheme:

- Options for changes to the Department's Blue Badge eligibility criteria that have to be made to enable any passported benefits from Personal Independence Payments.
- Extending the eligibility criteria for a Blue Badge to include children between the ages 2-3 with specific medical conditions.
- Changing the application process for obtaining a Blue Badge.
- Moving to the same central database and Blue Badge design and issue as the rest of the UK.
- Increasing the fee (possibly gradually) for a Blue Badge and replacement badges.
- Consideration of whether there is a need for Blue Badge Holders to park for free in the Department's car parks

The public consultation runs until Tuesday 30th July 2013 and as part of the consultation process we want to hear your views and ideas about the proposals and the accompanying screening analysis.

The Department for Employment and Learning has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Student Fees (Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013" (S.R. 2013 No. 120), which comes into operation on 18 June 2013.

The purpose of this Statutory Rule is to provide for the annual inflationary increases to the cap on tuition fees for qualifying persons on qualifying courses at Northern Ireland higher education institutions for academic year 2014/15. The maximum amounts of basic and higher fee rate for the 2014/15 academic year will increase to **£1,465** and **£3,685** respectively. For an academic year of certain courses, for example "sandwich courses", lower basic and higher fee amounts will increase to **£720** and **£1,835** respectively.
