THE INFANT FORMULA AND FOLLOW-ON FORMULA (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2014

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety has made the Statutory Rule is made under the powers conferred by Articles 15(1)(e), 16(1), and 47(2) of the Food Safety (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 and section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and is subject to the negative resolution procedure.

These Regulations are necessary to meet the following policy objectives:

To amend the Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007, in order to implement Commission Directive 2013/46/EU of 28 August 2013, amending Directive 2006/141/EC with regard to protein requirements for infant formula and follow-on formula.

The new provisions are to:

- Authorise for the first time the use of goats' milk protein in the manufacture of infant formula and follow-on formula milks; and
- Lower the minimum protein levels permitted in follow-on formula manufactured from protein hydrolysates, to bring it in line with that for infant formula.
