

HERRING INDUSTRY BOARD.
HERRING INDUSTRY SCHEME, 1935.

The Herring Industry Board hereby give notice that on the 6th day of January, 1936, in exercise of their powers under the Herring Industry Scheme, 1935, they made Rules to take effect on the 1st day of February, 1936, prescribing:—

The date from which licences must be obtained by precessors of herring;

The forms of such licences and of applications therefor.
